The book presents papers on the ovarian triad of the primate menstrual cycle; the measurement of local glucose utilization and its use in localization of functional activity in the central nervous system of animals and human; and the impact of estrogens on hypothalamic nerve cells. The text also describes the biosynthesis, processing, and secretion of parathormone and secretory protein-1; gastrointestinal peptides; chemical and biological characterization of corticotropin releasing factor; and the regulation of kidney functions by hormones. They emigrated sometime after the birth of their fourth child in 1881 and settled in Houghton County, Michigan. They homesteaded in Askel, Baraga County, Michigan in 1896. Herman died in 1916.
